

Cancellation policy Lumière Cup 2020

If we decide or are forced to cancel Lumière Cup between 2 November 2020 and Wednesday 9 December 2020 (the day before the draw of the ISU International competition) all registration fees will be reimbursed, all other costs (meals, extra training etc.) will be reimbursed except those costs paid for services to be made available on or before the day we decide to cancel.

If the Lumière Cup is cancelled or halted, or if the ice rink is closed after 9 December 2020 it is considered to be during the competition and we will not be able to reimburse any costs regardless the possibility of the teams to enjoy any services or other benefits they have paid for.

If teams withdraw after 2 November 2020 for any reason no reimbursement of registration costs will be made, unless otherwise agreed upon by the OC, and at the discretion of the OC, in advance of entry to the competition. Extra costs (meals, extra training etc.) will only be reimbursed when the OC can prevent making those costs themselves. The OC is committed to limit those costs as much as reasonable.

Under no circumstance will the OC reimburse or compensate for payments made to other parties than the OC itself, this includes but is not limited to travel and accommodation expenses, visa or legal costs or medical costs including testing for COVID-19.

For Judges we will provide hotel accommodation and meals even if the event is cancelled but only if they are already in The Netherlands and it is necessary to do so. The risk of travel expenses is for the federation nominating the Judge. The OC can make other arrangements with Judges if necessary and at their discretion. The other officials will be reimbursed for either the travel costs or the cancellation fees if applicable and necessary, as long as their travel arrangements are made after consultation with the OC.
