ANNOUNCEMENT LUMIÈRE CUP 2026

The Dutch Federation, Koninklijke Nederlandsche Schaatsenrijders Bond (KNSB), together with Stichting Lumière Cup, has the great pleasure of informing all ISU members that we will be organizing the 9th Lumière Cup from Thursday, January 22, 2026, until Sunday, January 25, 2026.

This International Synchronized Skating Competition will take place at the Ice Rink in Eindhoven, The Netherlands, and will include the following categories:

- Advanced Novice ISU
- Senior Elite 12 ISU

GENERAL RULES

The Lumière Cup 2026 will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution, ISU General Regulations 2024, and Special Regulations & Technical Rules for Synchronized Skating 2024 and the relevant ISU Communications. The teams must belong to an ISU Member, and the ages must be within the limits specified in Rule 108. All skaters must qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102 and participation and citizenship requirements according to Rule 109. This is for all categories.

TECHNICAL DATA

The technical data for all categories is:

- Senior Elite 12 ISU: according to ISU regulations.
 At least 17 years before the 1st of July 2025, 12 skaters with a maximum of 4 alternates.
 - Short Program 2 minutes and 50 seconds, but may be less. Factor 1.33
 - Free Skating program 4 minutes (+/- 10 sec) Factor 2.67 Well Balanced Program Content according to Communication 2692 Senior Elite 12 Short Program and Senior Elite 12 Free Skating.
- Advanced Novice ISU: according to ISU regulations.
 At least 10 years old and have not reached the age of 16 before the 1st of July 2025, 12-16 skaters with a maximum of 4 alternates.
 - Free Skating program 3 minutes (+/- 10 sec) Factor 2.67
 Well Balanced Program Content according to Communication 2692 Advanced Novice Free Skating.

VENUE

The competition will be held in Eindhoven, the Netherlands at the ice rink IJSSPORTCENTRUM EINDHOVEN. The competition rink is covered, closed, and heated, measures 60 x 30 meters, and has a seating capacity of approximately 1.700 seats.

The outdoor training rink is covered, not closed, and not heated and measures 60 x 30 meters. The competition and official practice will only take place at the indoor rink.

PRE-ENTRY/ENTRY

ENTRY FEE

Advanced Novice $: \in 650 \text{ per team}$ Senior Elite 12 $: \in 750 \text{ per team}$

These entry fees do not include any extra practice ice.

The payment of the entry fee must be received on the bank account of Stichting Lumière Cup latest at the final closing date of entries on the **14th of November 2025**, by credit transfer (the bank draft expenses will be charged to the registering teams and not to the organiser of the competition). No refunds can be given after the 14th of November 2025. The team registration will be valid only after payment of the entry fee.

Teams that sent in the pre-entry in an earlier stage are urgently requested to inform the organisation if the team will not participate in the end. Please notify the organisation as soon as possible, but before the 14th of November 2025.

SPORTITY APP

During the competition, the Sportity app will be used for announcing all information regarding the competition. The Sportity app can be downloaded from Google Play and Apple App Store.





UNOFFICIAL PRACTICE ICE

Unofficial practice ice for all teams is available on Wednesday, January 21st, and Thursday, January 22nd, at IJssportcentrum Eindhoven. For earlier unofficial practice ice, please contact us. It is possible to reserve practice ice per block of 15 minutes. Costs are € 100 per block for the indoor rink, which is available on Wednesday and Thursday. The costs are € 75 per block for the outdoor rink, which is available on Wednesday and Thursday. The outside rink is open but roofed. The measurement of both rinks is 60 x 30 meters. Please use the online form provided to order any practice ice link Extra practice ice must be paid in advance, directly after the reservation request.

PROGRAM CONTENT SHEETS

With the entry forms, the "Program Content Sheet" must be submitted through ORS to the Organizing Committee in time. It is mandatory that the Program Content Sheet be filled in precisely by each Team in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication.

LIST OF TEAM MEMBERS

The names of all team members must be submitted via the ISU Online Registration System (ORS) and must reach the Organizing Committee and the ISU Secretariat not later than **Friday**, **14 November 2025** – **20:00 h (Central European (Paris) Time, UTC+1)**.

The national passport of each skater of the teams taking part in the competition will be checked during the accreditation. Names of team members can be adjusted up until accreditation.

JUDGES & OFFICIALS

The panel of Judges is composed for each category:

- 1 Referee
- 5-7 Judges
- 1 Technical Controller
- 1 Technical Specialist
- 1 Assistant Technical Specialist
- 2 Data/Replay operator

Each participant country may enter one judge. Travel, accommodation, and meals will be paid for the Technical panel and the Referee by the organizing committee, as well as the accommodation and meals for the judges. Teams are invited to bring judges as well as technical panels. Please be aware that all judges must be nominated through ORS **before the closing date for the final entry date**.

JUDGES AND TECHNICAL PANEL MEETING

The initial Judges Meeting and initial Technical panel meeting are planned to take place at IJSSPORTCENTRUM EINDHOVEN on the evening of Thursday, the 22nd of January 2026.

STARTING ORDER/DRAW

The starting order will be determined by draw. The draw will be done on Thursday, the 22nd of January 2026, and will be published on the competition website, competition Facebook page, and Sportity app not later than 23:59. The starting order for the Free Skating will be in reverse order of the result of the Short Program for the Senior Elite 12 category.

OFFICIAL PRACTICE

Each team will be allocated a period of official practice on the competition rink described in the table below:

The music will start:

- In the practice of 10 minutes: After 1:30 minutes and after 6:00 minutes
- In the practice of 12 minutes: After 1:30 minutes and after 7:00 minutes

The organizing committee intends to plan all official practices on the same day as the competition for all programs of all categories. The schedule will depend on the number of teams taking part in the competition.

MUSIC

All Competitors shall furnish competition music of excellent quality by email in MP3 format only, in accordance with Rule 823. A list of titles, composers, and orchestras of the music to be used for the Short Program and Free Skating Program must be listed for each Team on the official Music Selection Form and attached to the official Entry Form for Teams.

The MP3 files shall be named <Program>_<category>_<country abbreviation>_<team name>.mp3

For example: Short_Senior_NED_Team_Illumination.mp3.

Upload the files to the Google form (<u>link</u>). In case of technical difficulties, please email to lumierecup@hotmail.com.

In accordance with Rule 823, all Teams must announce the exact running time of the music (not skating time), which shall be certified by the Team, Coach, Team Manager, or Team Leader at the time of registration.

In addition, Teams must provide at registration a backup for each program in MP3 format on a separate USB thumb drive for each program. The thumb drives shall be formatted for Windows (NTFS, FAT32, or exFAT) with only the MP3 file of the program in the main (root) directory, without other files or directories.

If music information is not complete and/or the music is not provided, accreditation will not be given.

We request all teams to check the music submitted at accreditation.

The music files will be deleted by the organizers shortly after the competition. The backup thumb drives will be returned to the teams at the info desk.

VICTORY CEREMONY

A victory ceremony will be held right after the last skating program of the day. Trophies will be awarded to the top three teams in each category. Medals will be presented to all skaters (1 per competitor) of the teams. All skaters from all teams are invited to take part in the closing ceremony on the ice. We will fill you in with the details at a later stage.

PROVISIONAL TIME SCHEDULE

A provisional time schedule will be published after the closing date of the entry date. The intention of the organizing committee is to follow the days as stated in the provisional event schedule at the end of this document.

REGISTRATION & ACCREDITATION

All participating teams and officials are invited to register for accreditation from Thursday, 22nd of January, or by appointment on Wednesday, 21st of January 2026, at the IJssportcentrum Eindhoven. A welcoming/accreditation/info desk will be in place at the ice rink from Thursday the 22nd of January 2026, and during the whole competition. Every team will receive passes for team members as mentioned in the team list. Every team will also receive passes for 1 manager, 1 coach, 1 assistant coach, and 2 team chaperones through ORS. For the chaperones, please send us an email with the names.

Every ISU Member can bring one Team Leader to the International Competition. The Team Leader must be announced through ORS.

RULES ALONGSIDE THE ICE RINK DURING COMPETITION

Please be advised that every team will get one card for each accredited coach and assistant coach. These cards will give access to the ice rink side during the competition performance of the team. At no point will additional skaters or team personnel be allowed next to the ice during the competition, except a maximum of 4 alternates.

Non-accredited skaters do not have access to restricted areas.

DOPING

An anti-doping control can take place and will be in accordance with the valid ISU Anti-Doping Rules. It is also not permitted to use alcohol during the competition by any of the competitors.


